ProofBase Universal Acrylic Primer is sold in ready to apply 15l and 5l tubs.



15l = 120m²



5l = 40m²

Mix with clean water at a ratio of 1:1

Apply with brush or roller

Properties

- Highly vapour permeable
- Hydrophobic acrylic formulation
- Easily applied using a roller or brush
- Rapid drying

Composition

- Water
- Acrylic Polymers in dispersion
- Silica aggregate

Handling and Storage

- Wear gloves and eye protection when handling/using
- Keep out of reach of children
- Clean spillages and tools with detergent and water
- Store at temperatures above 4c and below 35c and in a normally ventilated area

Disposal
